Cafe within the ground will be open but restricted to window service only and the surrounding area marked with 1M distance strips to encourage social distancing. The Hospitality Room within the Ground will have limited access to the following; Prior to Match - Club Secretaries / Team Management x 2 ONLY Half Time - Home Officials x 6 / Away Officals x 3 Full Time - Club Secretaries / Social Media Team.
